WELL HELLO THERE!

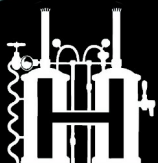

Fabulous authentic Greek food



WHEN the pandemic struck In 2020, food-loving friends Nikos and Sukh saw an opportunity to bring authentic Greek flavours to Cambridge. Nikos, a seasoned chef, found himself out of work, while Sukh, an Optometrist, was volunteering at an emergency clinic in Bar Hill. Determined to turn a challenge into an opportunity, they decided to set up a Greek kitchen in a well-established pub, serving takeaways during lockdown -a move that proved to be a game-changer.

Within just a week of exploring their options, they received three offers for kitchen spaces. Ten days after accepting one at Mill Road's Royal Standard, TZATZIKI was born — named after a dog they met in Thessaloniki. The concept took off, and just five months later, they expanded to London with a second location. The reason for their rapid success? Simply taste their food. Signature dishes include their overnight-roasted Greek marinated lamb souvlaki with fresh tzatziki wrapped in pillowy pitta, chunky Greek sausages, flaky spanakopita, and crispy, truffle honey-drizzled feta pies.
